

You advised that you were aware of the incident and was able to show and copy for the officer CCTV footage of the incident. The CCTV footage for outside the premises was not discernible so could not be used. You said that security had asked a male patron to leave as he was being abusive and had tried to hit another patron. The male was very verbal to security as they walked him to the exit. He then refused to leave and tried to hit security. You said that staff had seen police drive past and they were waved down to assist. They then took the male patron away. At no time did you see the male assaulted, nor did you see any injury to the mans leg. The CCTV footage did not show security assaulting the male patron, only showing him to the exit, albeit very slowly.

OLGR now reminds the licensee and management of their obligations under the *Liquor Act 1992* (the *Liquor Act*).

Section 148A(4) of the *Liquor Act* states:

Obligations of licensees and permittees relating to the service, supply and promotion of liquor

(1) This section imposes obligations on licensees and permittees in the conduct of business on licensed premises or premises to which a permit relates for—

*(a) maintaining a safe environment for patrons and staff of the premises; and
(b) ensuring liquor is served, supplied and promoted in a way that is compatible with minimising harm from the use of liquor and preserving the peace and good order of the neighbourhood of the premises.*

(2) The licensee or permittee must not engage in a practice or promotion that may encourage rapid or excessive consumption of liquor.


(3) The licensee or permittee must engage in practices and promotions that encourage the responsible consumption of liquor.

(4) The licensee or permittee must provide and maintain a safe environment in and around the premises.
