I am the officer within the Strategic Policy and Legal Services division of the Department of Justice and Attorney-General who is currently considering possible amendments to the Coroners Act 2003 regarding the investigation of stillbirths. Amber Manwaring (a colleague within my area) was previously working with QMPQC in relation this. During such time, QMPQC provided statistics with respect to the number of intrapartum stillbirths that occurred during 2009-11.

However, as I am now considering this issue, and the previous statistics are out-of-date, I made a request to QMPQC for more current/recent statistics. QMPQC has referred me to yourself.

Accordingly, can you please provide me with statistics regarding the number of stillbirths that occurred during 2012-2014, what proportion of this number occurred during labour, how many weeks gestation the foetuses were (if possible) and how many would warrant independent review.
