

Re: Draft Calendar July 2015 - January 2016

I enclose a copy of my proposed draft calendar for the second half of 2015 together with the questionnaire circulated by Justice Byrne for the purposes of the calendar arrangements.

The provisions that I have made for circuits to Mackay and Mount Isa have been made after consultations with both Justice McMeekin and Justice Henry who will include provision for their circuits in their calendars.

The discussions I have had with their Honours and the registrars in Mackay and Mount Isa suggest that the arrangements that have been put in place for circuits will be adequate to meet foreseeable contingencies.

The calendar that I have enclosed should be regarded as provisional at least in respect to the proposed Court of Appeal sittings in Brisbane. They roughly coincide with the weeks in the year when I have sat in Brisbane in prior years. I have written to the President asking if the proposed dates are convenient. Hi Rachel

Brett Moody is the Registrar at Toowoomba - his email is set out below. The District Court is certainly sitting for the proposed dates (between 13 April and 24 April) - as Brett states, there will not be a courtroom available for the Chief Justice.

If Justice P Lyons is to conduct the next sittings in Toowoomba, the registry will provide HH with the list so he can conduct a callover and set matters down for hearing during the circuit.

Justice P Lyons is the only judge on circuit in the fortnight commencing 27 April so if the Chief Justice wishes to sit at the same time that would not be a problem (the second courtroom would be available). Justice P Lyons will also need to determine when he wishes to go to Maryborough – it may be that the Chief Justice could sit in Toowoomba for the days HH is not in Toowoomba.

If the Chief Justice would like to sit at the same time it would be a good idea to liaise with Justice P Lyons prior to the callover. At this stage it doesn't look like it will be possible to conduct sittings beforehand.

Otherwise I have been advised that there are no judges circuiting to Toowoomba in the week commencing 11 May, which would directly follow on from Justice P Lyons' circuit.

### Hi Rachel

I just received a call from Lyn Owen regarding the proposed sittings at Mt Isa in the week commencing 10 August 2015.

As you will recall there was talk that one matter may be ready to go to trial. Lyn has spoken to the DPP who consider that it is very unlikely that the matter will be ready to go to trial at that time because there are a lot of witnesses and there will be significant difficulty in getting accommodation at that time. There are not likely to be any other matters to be heard.

Lyn advised that North J is scheduled to circuit to Mt Isa on 5 October (after the long weekend). That is scheduled to be a two week circuit. She suggested that it is more likely that the trial will be in a position to proceed at that time.

The Chief Justice is formulated his court circuit calendar for the second half of 2015. His Honour proposes to circuit to Townsville the week commencing 27 July 2015.

The Chief Justice is happy to adjust the calendar if the proposed week is not suitable. Mr Chris Stackpoole, the Chief Justice's associate, will contact the Townsville Registrar once confirmation is received.

### Mount Isa

The Chief Justice was looking to circuit to Mount Isa in August.
