the Queensland Law Society, on (07) 3842 5888 and ask them for the names of legal firms which specialise
in your particular type of legal problem.

If, after seeking legal advice, you wish to proceed further, you may wish to lodge a claim with the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal (QCAT) where matters in dispute between consumers and traders, for amounts up to \$25000, can be heard. QCAT can be contacted by telephoning 1300 753 228 in Brisbane or your local courthouse.

Details of your complaint have been recorded on our computerised database to allow for monitoring of the trader's business practices and the formulation of pro-active strategies to improve consumer protection generally.
