IMPLEMENTATION OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE INTERVENTION PROGRAMS

I am writing to you as the local Councillor for Division 11 in response to the surge in drug and alcohol-fuelled violence and crime which is plaguing our community. Enclosed is a copy of a recent article that appeared in the Jimboomba Times, where one of my constituents made commentary regarding an application by Jimboomba Tavern to extend its trading hours and the impacts this may have on residents.

In recent times, there has been extensive media coverage about the negative impacts that drug and alcohol abuse has on every aspect of our society. The issue of substance abuse extends way beyond individuals and their addictions which can result in devastating effects across entire communities. I strongly believe that it is of paramount importance that the Queensland Government needs to adopt and implement a range of measures across our society which address the issues related to substance abuse, including the prevalence of non-domestic alcohol-fuelled violence. This can only be achieved by a reduction, and certainly not an increase, in the trading hours of licenced premises.

A recent landmark decision by the former Independent Liquor Administration Board in New South Wales imposed mandatory precinct-wide preventative measures in Newcastle, including the supply of alcohol and a reduction in trading hours. These measures were implemented to curb alcohol-related violence. The widely-publicised dramatic results of this intervention program have been phenomenal in reducing crime and non-domestic assaults, as well as demands on public health, policing and costs to the community.

I fully support the adoption of similar regulatory measures to be applied to licenced premises in Queensland, as well as accessible intervention programs for at-risk groups across our community.

I am seeking support from the Queensland Government for the implementation of community intervention programs such as the Newcastle Model in the Logan City Council area. I ask that you contact me directly on (07) 3412 5511 to discuss this and other community-related matters.
