I, [redacted] Custodial Correctional Officer (CCO) was rostered on duty from 0630 hrs to 1830hrs, [redacted] at the Woodford Correctional Centre on Monday 10th August 2015.

Near to the time of 1250 Prisoner [redacted] was advised by the [redacted] officer that his [redacted] medication would not be provided till the evening medication parade as the nurse advised [redacted] staff that this was to happen.

At approximately 1300hrs Prisoner [redacted] domiciled in cell [redacted] and then was observed by staff [redacted] throw it at his rear cell window. Shortly after this at approximately 1306hrs the rear cell window was smashed [redacted] Throughout the entirety of this the prisoner was given multiple directions to [redacted] cease his behaviour. The prisoner refused to comply with any of these directions and called staff "fucking scum dogs, you cunts brought this on your selves", or words to that effect.

Shortly after this at approximately 1315hrs Prisoner [redacted] then smashed his cell [redacted]

At approximately 1426 [redacted] we entered the cell [redacted] for the purpose of doing a cell relocation [redacted] Prisoner [redacted]

[redacted] The prisoner was then escorted to cell [redacted] without further incident. Once the Prisoner had been secured in cell [redacted] Prisoner [redacted] then spat on his cell camera and covered it. The prisoner was then seen to by medical staff at a later time.

I, Custodial Correctional Officer (CCO) was rostered on duty from 0630 to 1830, on Saturday 29th August 2015.

At approximately 1850 hours I was waiting out the front of Cell which accommodated Prisoner. Clearly yelling to the cell next door I heard Prisoner state to Prisoner - "I have a container full of cum and blood, shit and urine and I'm going to get these fucking cunts with it". Prior to this Prisoner had made similar threats to staff directly about covering them in urine and shit and had thrown urine staff at the evening medication parade just prior.

Under the direction of /Duty Manager I entered Cell in the company of CCO also present was C/Supervisor

Upon entry to the cell the Prisoner threw a container which appeared to be and smelt like urine, faeces and other body waste. This liquid made contact with my head and shoulder area. Reasonable force, using departmental techniques, was then used to ground stabilize the Prisoner on the bed.

Prisoner was striking out at staff using his feet and hands and attempting to bite CCO who was controlling the Prisoners' head. At all times the Prisoner was given clear directions to comply and stop resisting.

Due to the prisoner's non-compliance distraction techniques were used on the prisoner.

As the prisoner was escorted [Sch4/3/10] he again was non-compliant and ground stabilized.

Prisoner [Sch4/3/3] was then inserted into Cell []

The prisoner throughout the process was making continual threats to staff that []

As Officers were preparing to exit the cell Prisoner [] continued to make threats such as []

Staff then safely exited the cell without further incident.

Sir I Custodial Correctional Officer (CCO) [REDACTED] was rostered on duty on the 29th August 2015 from 06:30 to 18:30hrs [REDACTED] at Woodford Correctional Centre.

At about 18:50hrs I was tasked by Duty Manager [REDACTED] to prepare to enter cell [REDACTED] which is occupied by prisoner [REDACTED] this was in response to prisoner [REDACTED]
[REDACTED]

During preparation to enter the cell prisoner [REDACTED] was clearly heard shouting to another prisoner "I have a container of shit,cum, blood and piss for these cunts" the prisoner had earlier thrown urine at Staff.

I entered the cell along with CCO [REDACTED] Supervisor [REDACTED] and Duty Manager [REDACTED] were also present prisoner [REDACTED] threw the contents of a milk container which was consistent in look and smell of urine and excrement this liquid connected with all Staff involved the floor of the cell was also covered in water and soap.

I took control of the prisoner's right arm, during this process Prisoner [REDACTED] was continually attempting to bite me CCO [REDACTED] applied approved pressure point techniques to deter the prisoner from biting, throughout the restraint process Prisoner [REDACTED] struggled violently all the time threatening all Staff present despite being constantly instructed to stop resisting.

Prisoner [REDACTED] was re-located to cell [REDACTED] where Staff exited safely Prisoner immediately covered the cell camera with excrement.

I, Custodial Correctional Officer (CCO) was rostered on duty from 0600 to 1800, at the Woodford Correctional Centre on Saturday 29th August 2015.

Close to the time of 1850 I was waiting out the front of Cell domiciled by Prisoner and I could clearly hear the prisoner state to Prisoner accommodated in the cell adjacent to him that "I have a container full of cum, blood, shit and urine and I'm going to get these cunts with it". Prior to this Prisoner had made multiple threats to staff about covering them in "urine and cum and shit" and had thrown urine staff at the evening medication parade.

Near to the time of 1901 under the direction I entered cell with the other Officers. Upon entry to the cell the Prisoner threw a container which I know now was filled with urine, faeces and other body waste matters at me. Necessary force was then used to ground stabilize the Prisoner on the bed. The Prisoner was striking out at staff using his feet and hands and while I was attempting to gain control of the Prisoners head he turned his head and attempted to bite my arm on numerous occasions. Necessary force was then used to deflect the prisoners head away from my arms and try to gain control of the Prisoners head. Throughout the entirety of this the Prisoner was told to stop resisting and comply with direction to which the prisoner did not at any stage comply with.

The prisoner was then being escorted when he then again resisted against officers attempts to escort him so the prisoner was then again ground stabilized.

The prisoner was then stood to his feet and escorted to cell Throughout the entirety of the escort the prisoner was making continual threats to staff that

The Prisoner was then placed on his stomach in cell [redacted] so that staff could safely [redacted]
[redacted] exit the cell. Further to this [redacted]
[redacted] the prisoner was again making further threats to staff [redacted]
[redacted] Staff then safely exited the cell without further
incident. Shortly after this to the best of my knowledge the prisoner was then seen to by
medical staff.

Throughout the entirety of this the Prisoner was told to stop resisting and comply with direction to which the prisoner did not at any stage comply with. Due to the prisoner's non-compliance distraction techniques

Prisoner [redacted] had covered the cell door viewing panel with paper and was shouting out to the prisoner in the next cell "I have a container full of cum and blood and shit and piss and I'm going to get these cunts with it"

Under the direction of the [redacted] Duty Manager [redacted] officers [redacted] entered cell [redacted] As they entered [redacted] threw a container which was I now know was filled with urine, faeces and other unknown substances at the officers.

The liquid from the container soaked the officer's protective overalls and helmets and spread onto the cell floor.

[redacted] was eventually ground stabilised on the bed. He was striking out at the officers with his feet and hands whilst the officers attempted to place handcuffs on him.

The officers were continually telling [redacted] to stop resisting and to comply with their direction but [redacted] would not listen and kept struggling.

[redacted] was eventually [redacted] escorted out of the cell during which he again resisted and was again ground stabilised [redacted]

The Prisoner was placed on the wall in preparation for his cell being searched. The prisoner became argumentative over demanding a phone call and advised that if he continued he would forfeit his yard time and be placed back in his cell.

The prisoner became abusive and non-compliant and was instructed that he would be taken back to his cell.

The Prisoner was then placed in his cell against the wall on the bed and then the Prisoner became physically resistive towards staff and attempted to push back off the wall and break free from staff restraining him. Minimal force was used to gain compliance from the Prisoner on the bed and then the prisoner was placed on the floor of the cell [REDACTED] safely exit the cell. The prisoner was constantly given directions to stop resisting, he did not follow this direction at any time.

Staff exited the cell and medical staff attended to check on the prisoner.

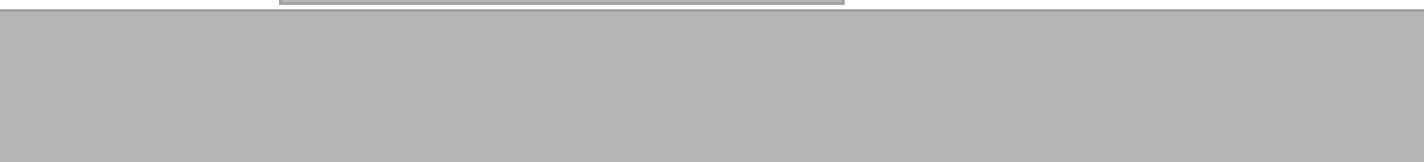
