

Requested Information	Response
1. Number of offenders subject to DPSOA orders at 24 May 2016	As at 24 May 2016 there were 147 offenders subject to DPSOA orders. 100 of these offenders were living in the community.
2. Number of DPSOA offenders subject to GPS monitoring	As at 24 May 2016 there were 94 offenders subject to GPS monitoring.
3. Number of DPSOA offenders in custody	As at 24 May 2016 there were 47 DPSOA offenders in custody.
4. Between 23 May 2015 to 24 May 2016 the number of contraventions of DPSOA supervision orders and a breakdown of the types of contraventions	Between 23 May 2015 to 24 May 2016, there were 531 contraventions of DPSOA supervision orders, not including criminal charges by the Queensland Police Service. Of these, 501 contraventions resulted in an official warning and 30 resulted in a section 20 warrant being issued by a Magistrate with the offender returned to the Supreme Court and detained on contravention.
5. How many resulted in a criminal charge by QPS and a breakdown of those criminal charges	This would need to be sourced from the Queensland Police Service.
6. The number of Section 20 warrants issued on DPSOAs and the related incident reports (de-identified)	Between 23 May 2015 to 24 May 2016 there were 30 section 20 warrants issued on DPSOAs (please see <i>attachment 1</i> for the relevant incident reports).
