6.5 Removal/ Extradition

The Parole Board may grant a prisoner parole subject to their removal from Australia or extradition from Queensland.

Following a decision by the Board the designated officer will complete a parole order. A specific release date is not included within this order.

The correspondence is sent to the Correctional Centre where the prisoner is located.

Sentence management services will liaise with Corrective Services Intelligence Unit, Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) or other relevant Agencies/Departments regarding the prisoner's release.
