

Prisoners entering QCS custody self report Indigenous status. Where a person fails or refuses to identify, they will not be recorded as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander or both.

Three variables have been used to identify the area were an Indigenous prisoner may identify as where they come from:

- Prisoners can also voluntarily identify :
 - (1) the Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander Community which they were originally from;
 - (2) the Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander Community in which they are a resident/ live; and
- (3) 'last known address' – the suburb of the most recent address listed on the Integrated Offender Management System (IOMS). This can be a business address, residential address or the address of a residential facility.

A prisoner can have a different locality listed in all three categories and have different or no community reported in categories (1) and (2).

suburbs with the same name, a further delineation was made by post codes. It is important to note that some suburbs with the same name and post code may be divided between multiple LGAs. Delineation to street level was not undertaken. Therefore data should be used with caution. Examples of affected suburbs are provided below. In those cases where more than one LGA may apply, records have been assigned the first LGA based on alphabetical order.
