Thank you for your letter dated 13 July 2016, requesting compensation for the remainder of your property which you claim was lost during transfer between Southern Queensland Correctional Centre (SQCC) and Woodford Correctional Centre. I apologise for the delay in responding.

A further investigation has been undertaken in relation to the remainder of your missing property. Queensland Corrective Services (QCS) records state that your Oakley sunglasses were marked as "in transit" and subsequent searches have been unable to locate this item. Therefore, your request for reimbursement of your Oakley sunglasses has been approved.

When determining compensation for property claims, the condition of the property as recorded on IOMS and the value of the property is taken into consideration. QCS has determined that based on the condition code, you are entitled to 75% of the original value of the item, and therefore you will be reimbursed \$300.00.

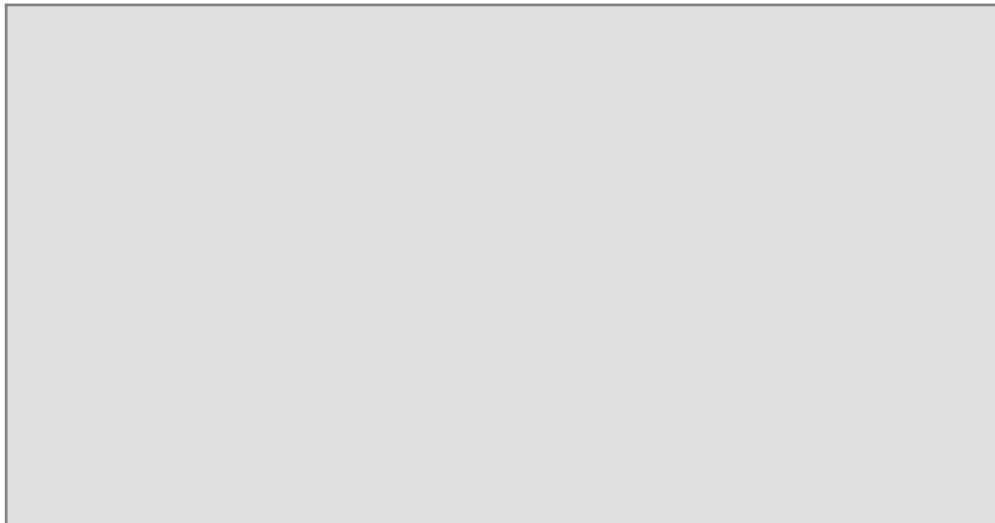
