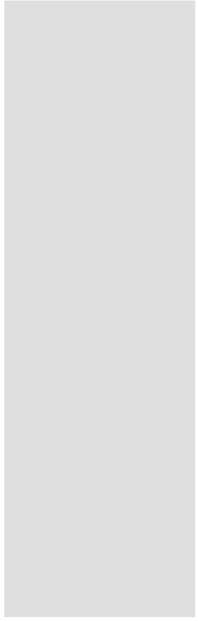
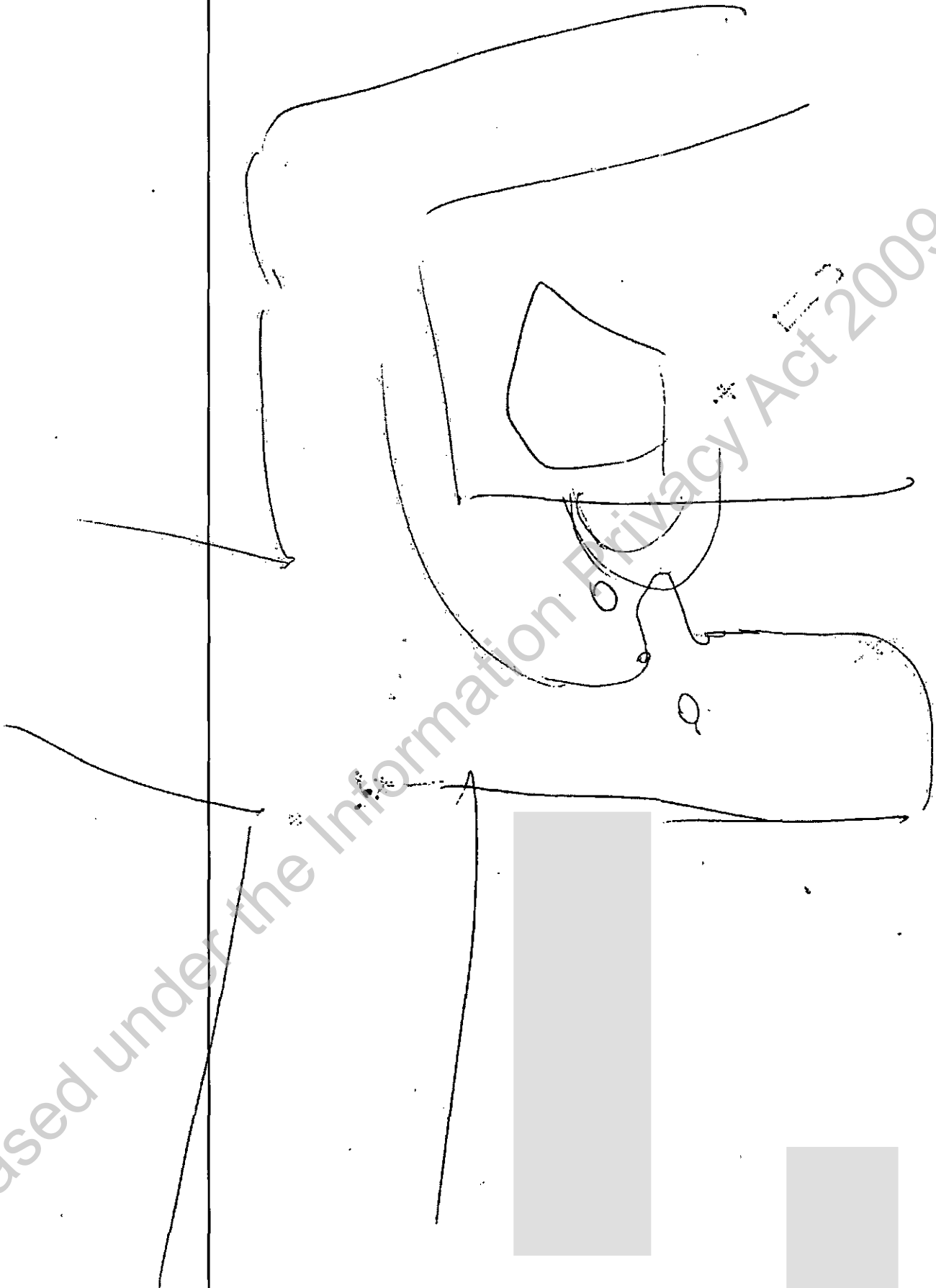

INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION

Transport Planning and Coordination Act 1994
Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995

1. I, NEIL SCALES, the Chief Executive of the Department of Transport and Main Roads, in executing the power of delegation provided under section 37 of the *Transport Planning and Coordination Act 1994*, and under section 103 of the *Public Service Act 2008*, delegate the powers conferred on me by the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to the persons who hold the offices specified in Column 3 subject to the limitations specified in Column 5.
2. The delegates in Column 3 of the Schedule may not sub-delegate the powers the subject of this delegation, except that the following powers may be sub-delegated:
 - the powers under section 68 of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* delegated to the Chief Executive Officers of the various port authorities, the Port of Brisbane Corporation and the Ports Corporation of Queensland.
3. The description of the powers provided in Column 2 does not limit the scope of the powers delegated in Column 1 of the Schedule.
4. In this Instrument of Delegation, a reference to an Act includes amending, consolidating or replacing legislation and any statutory instruments made under that Act.
5. If the name of an office mentioned in this Instrument of Delegation is redesignated or retitled, but the duties, functions and responsibilities attached to the office remain substantially the same, then the reference to the office in this Instrument shall be read as if it is a reference to the redesignated or retitled office.
6. This Instrument of Delegation is comprised of this delegation and Schedule comprising 37 pages. No other written material forms part of the Instrument.
7. This Instrument of Delegation commences on the date it is signed.
8. This Instrument of Delegation revokes all previous Instruments of Delegation made by the Chief Executive in relation to the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* from the date this Instrument of Delegation commences.
