The Attorney-General appreciated the your attendance alongside other impacted families at Queensland Parliament to witness the passage of the Corrective Services (No Body, No Parole) Amendment Bill 2017 (the Bill) on 10 August 2017.

Upon commencement, the Bill will apply a No Body, No Parole policy to applications for a parole order from prisoners serving a period of imprisonment for a prescribed *homicide offence* where the body or remains of the victim of the offence have not been located; or because of an act or omission of the prisoner or another person, parts of the body or remains of the victim have not been located.

The term *homicide offence* is particularly broad, and is defined to capture the offences of murder, manslaughter, conspiring to murder, misconduct with regard to corpses, unlawful striking causing death; an offence of being an accessory after the fact or any of these offences; or an offence of counselling or procuring the commission of, or conspiring the commission of, any of these offences.

The definition also captures offences from another jurisdiction that substantially correspond with a Queensland offence prescribed in the definition of *homicide offence*, in circumstances where the applicant prisoner has been transferred to a Queensland prison under the *Prisoners* (*Interstate Transfer*) Act 1982.

The Bill provides that if the parole board is not satisfied the prisoner has cooperated satisfactorily in the investigation of the offence to identify the victim's location, the parole board must refuse the application. Importantly, the No Body, No Parole policy

(2)

in the Bill also applies to a parole application whether the prisoner was convicted of, or sentenced for, the offence before or after commencement.

Although I note the specific concerns raised in your correspondence, the Attorney-General cannot interfere with individual parole applications, regardless of the circumstances. As individual parole matters fall under the ministerial responsibilities of the Honourable Mark Ryan MP, Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services and Minister for Corrective Services, I have referred a copy of your email to the office of Minister Ryan for his consideration.
