Dear Penni and Michael,

Here is some further information just received in case it is of assistance.

The Public Trustee regional office in Rockhampton currently provides services to 340 financial administration customers, is administering 123 deceased estates and 10 Trusts. Since January 2020 (approximately 15 months) a total of 18 complaints have been received by the Rockhampton office. This represents just under 3% of all complaints received by the Public Trustee in the last year. A total of 14 of these complaints relate to financial management. The key theme in the majority of these complaints related to the decision making about the customer's budget. All complaints have been, or are currently being managed through the PT's complaints management process.

As at December 2020, Rockhampton achieved the highest increase in customer satisfaction across all PT offices over the previous 6 months.

Positive relationships with local support and advocacy groups continues to grow in Rockhampton, with organisations such as Capricorn Citizen Advocacy Rockhampton and IFYS Limited being positively engaged to build a better understanding of the services that the Public Trustee can provide and how the organisations can work together to support their customers.

The Public Trustee welcomed the Public Advocate's report which is an important part of review and improvement. Since 2019, the Public Trustee has been implementing our Customers First Agenda and relevant initiatives to drive better outcomes for our customers and for Queensland.

We actively engage on a regular basis with our Customer Reference Group and Government Reference Group to ensure that we have integrity in our decisions and that our actions are directly benefiting our customers. With key advocacy and peak body groups on these reference groups, such as Aged and Disability Advocates Australia and the Public Advocate, we value their input into our review and implementation of the Public Advocate's report.

He said he wanted a "wide-ranging review" of the Public Trustee, which is a "very secretive service". He went on:

"One of the big areas where we have seen a lot of complaints come from is from the Central Queensland, Rockhampton area.

"We've had people in today who have told stories about their mothers' property being taken off them and they haven't really been given a reason.

"People who have had orders made maybe 15 years ago when they were ill and still don't have control of their own finances.

"People on a pension who are having \$200 a fortnight being taken out of their pension by the Public Trustee and they just don't know what they're getting for that money."

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Standard Response for Ministerials – Public Advocate Report, Fees and Charges

The Public Advocate has recently completed a review of the Public Trustee's fees, charges and practices. The Report found that many of the Public Trustee's customers receive a high level of service for very little or no cost.

The Report has however identified some opportunities for improvement in the way the Public Trustee engages with its customers.

The Government will be working in collaboration with the Public Trustee, the Public Advocate and other stakeholders to consider the best way to address the recommendations in the Public Advocate's Report.

The Public Trustee is undertaking an ambitious and industry leading program of work to ensure that Queenslanders can remain confident in the services they provide. The Customers First Agenda ensures that the customers are at the centre of all that the Public Trustee does. Many of the Public Advocate's recommendations are being addressed through this work.

This includes engaging with external stakeholders through customer and government reference groups and initiatives to enhance understanding of existing fees and charges.

The Public Trustee has also commenced a full independent review of its fees and charges to ensure fees charged for services are fair, equitable, sustainable and transparent. This will be the most comprehensive review of the Public Trustee's fees and charges in the last two decades.
