Hi Tony,

Thank you so much for returning my call on Tuesday morning (1/8/2023). I can only imagine your time pressures, and appreciate that you made the time to call.

As discussed, [redacted]
[redacted]

An autopsy was carried out [redacted] in Brisbane. I was contacted by phone by the Coroners Office shortly after the examination and advised that the autopsy was inconclusive and a cause of death could not yet be established. I was advised at that time that they had taken multiple tissue samples and would continue testing, but that an outcome could be "many months" away.

I have also received a letter from the Coroners court, essentially confirming this phone conversation in writing. (A copy is attached).

I have also received a death certificate, with the cause stated as "Yet To Be Determined". (A certified copy of the death certificate is attached)

[redacted] responded to my claim applications to advise that they are unable to process my applications until I can provide a cause of death, or at the very least, confirm for them in writing that [redacted] was not suspicious, not the subject of a Police investigation, and that no court cases are pending surrounding [redacted] death.

[redacted] I emailed the Coroner's Office on [redacted] to request the Coroner to provide me with a written statement that advised the death was not suspicious and not the subject of a Police investigation etc.

I received a response from the Coroner's Court [redacted] in which they advised "as the investigation is still ongoing regarding the formal cause of death, the only record we can provide at this stage is the Form 29 from the Forensic and Scientific Services (FSS)." (A copy of this email thread with the Coroner's Officer, and a copy of the Form 29 are attached for information).

Although I understand that this is due process for [redacted]
[redacted] this does not help me in any way overcome the financial difficulties that [redacted] death has left me with.

I am happy to wait for the cause of death in order to finalise the [redacted] however, if the Coroner's Office would only provide something in writing that states [redacted] not suspicious, not part of an ongoing Police investigation and there are no court outcomes pending, then this would be enough to satisfy [redacted] [redacted] instead of waiting for the medical cause to be determined.

Thank you for taking my call yesterday [redacted] regarding the coronial investigation into the death of [redacted]

[redacted] advising that unfortunately the claim must be placed on hold until they receive a cause of death. When I enquired further, it seems that the cause of death is required before they can proceed [redacted] to ensure that it wasn't a suspicious death being investigated by the Coroner, or that the death is not part of any police investigation or court actions.

I believe that once [redacted] in the mail, they will come back to me with a similar response.

Is it at all possible for the Coroner to provide me with something in writing to confirm that [redacted] is not suspicious, and there is no police investigation surrounding [redacted] death, nor any court actions, and that the coronial investigation is seeking to find a medical reason for [redacted] death??

I'm hoping that such confirmation in writing may provide them with enough information to proceed with processing [redacted] while we await an exact cause of death.

[redacted] although not large, will be a huge help to me in facing the frightening loss of [redacted] income, and [redacted] for the "many months" that determining a cause of death may take.

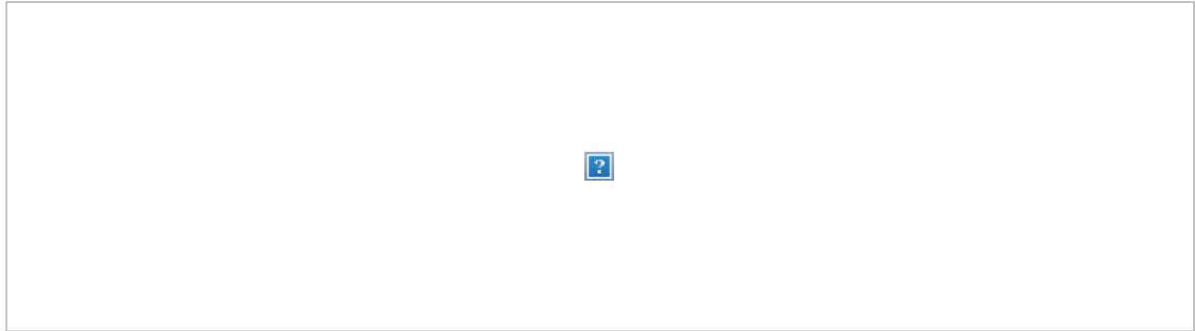

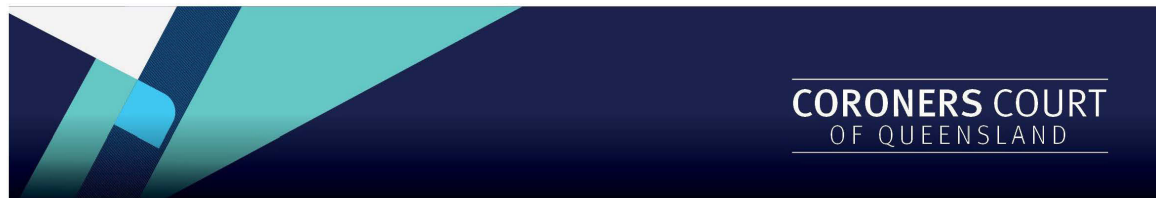
